

Advanced Placement Courses

The Advanced Placement program was developed and is sponsored by the College Entrance Examination Board, New York, New York. The Advanced Placement (AP) program provides course materials and examinations on introductory courses. Some high schools in Alberta offer some courses in the Advanced Placement program. Students who have successfully completed examinations in the program may apply for advance credit through individual assessment upon admission to a post-secondary institution. More information is available from the Office of the Registrar at each institution. Upon admission to UofA and UofC, all AP students will automatically receive advance standing (credit or placement) in approved courses where they have achieved AP grades of "4" or "5". At UofA, credit or placement granted is determined by the policy in effect for the session to which the student applies, NOT the date when the AP course was taken. At UofL and ACAD, students have the option of receiving transfer credit for approved courses where they have achieved grades of "4" or "5", or of taking the UofL or ACAD course. Where specified credit is not indicated, students with AP credits will be evaluated individually. At all receiving institutions, at least one official AP transcript is required. Advance credit arrangements are in effect at the universities and private colleges with accredited degree programs listed in the following table.

They may also challenge a junior or senior course for credit via the Credit by Special Assessment route, if they have appropriate qualifications and are eligible within the regulations.
